## June 2021 in the Cellar

Fred's White,

At the beginning of the month of June we bottled a new batch of our Lynfred Fred's White. This year our selected blend was 67 % Sauvignon Blanc, 30% Chardonnay and 3% Riesling. All grapes produced in Washington. This wine expresses clean and crispy aromas and flavors such as white flowers, green apple, mango, and Meyer lemon. Enjoy this refreshing wine on any occasion!

Plum,

During the month of June, we bottled a small batch of Plum wine. This refreshing sweet wine shows aromas and flavors of dried plums, cherry, and caramel. Enjoy our exclusive Lynfred Plum Wine with Asian cuisine or your favorite dessert.

Oktoberfest,

On June 4th, we bottled a new batch of Oktoberfest. A sweet white blend made with 87% Riesling and 13% Sauvignon blanc grapes. This refreshing white shows aromas and flavors of lychee, pear, lime, and honey. Lynfred's Oktoberfest wine is crafted to mimic some of Germany's best sweet, food-friendly white wine. It pairs beautifully with traditional German pub fare such as bratwurst, potato salad and Bavarian pretzels.

Norton Chambourcin 2018,

After a long aging of 24 months in American oak barrels we bottled a new and unique blend of Norton Chambourcin Vintage 2018, produced with grapes grown in Newton, Illinois.

Norton it is among only a few grapes native to North America, also a common grape grown here in the Midwest due to its ability to adapt to a variety of weather conditions, its durability, and its resistance to disease.

Chambourcin, a French American variety, is winter hardy and typically produces wines that are rich in color and juice acidity on the palate, but lighter bodied & less robust than the average red varieties. Blending both "Illinoisan" varieties and adding the finesse of a long aging in oak barrels we were able to highlight the unique characteristics of the Midwest wine grape growing region, such as cloves, menthol, earthy and woody aromas, and flavors. We invite you to discover this exclusive wine. This wine will be released to our club members on Sep 1st, 2021. Cheers!

Petit Verdot 2018,

At the end of the month of June we bottled an elegant and complex Petit Verdot. After 28 months of aging in American oak barrels we got a smooth and bold wine with interesting notes of boysenberry, vanilla, and earthy sage. Grapes from Heringer Vineyards, Clarksburg, CA.

To this new release we have added a touch of Merlot to "tame" the bold tannins of these superb Californian grapes. This wine will be released on October 1st to our club members. Enjoy this unique Lynfred Winery Petit Verdot Vintage 2018. Cheers!

Passion Fruit,

During this month we have been fermenting our aromatic Passion fruit wine! This delicious wine is the most important component of our Sangria Blanc. We are almost done and looking forward to work in the new blend of our summer favorite wine! Stay tuned.

Sparkling Almond,

Also, during this busy month of June, we have been working on the base wine of our Sparkling Almond. Riesling and Sauvignon Blanc will be the main components of the next batch.
