Vin de City Red

At the beginning of the month of December we bottled one of our favorites everyday red Wine, Vin De City Red. This versatile red blend has flavors of raspberries, maraschino cherries and herbs.

Sauvignon Blanc 2021

The white wine of the month of January 2022 will be Lynfred Winery Sauvignon Blanc 2021. Produced with grapes from Lodi, California. The result is an expressive white wine with aromas of citrus, white peach and green apple mingle with a bright and refreshing minerality. Enjoy this refreshing and unique Lynfred Winery Sauvignon Blanc Vintage 2021 with your favorite fish or seafood.

Assemblage 2019

During the month of December, we were working in our spectacular Assemblage 2019, after 24 months of aging in oak, we racked the wine from the barrels, now the wine is settling in a tank and ready to be bottle. This new Vintage 2019 was crafted using the co-fermentation technique. In this new edition we blended 66% of Petite Sirah and 34% of Teroldego grapes from Lodi, California. This exclusive wine will be released to our club members on February 1st of 2022.

Sparkling Peach

We bottled another gorgeous sparkling wine! Our delicious Sparkling Peach! To produce this mouthwatering Sparkling Peach wine, we used whole fresh Red Haven Peaches grown in Michigan. This dark red & golden

variety is well known as a dessert peach, and to be one of the top choices for bakers due its exceptional flavor. A clean and slowly fermentation in stainless steel tanks at 55° F produced a crisp and refreshing base wine. The second fermentation, where the bubbles are produced, was made through Charmat Method allowing the development of a beautiful perlage and elegant secondary flavors. Enjoy this fruity and sweet Sparkling Peach during the holidays. Cheers!

Blueberry Wine

Using selected fresh blueberries from Covert, Michigan, we crafted this exclusive dessert wine that expresses the rich flavors of ripe blueberries. The wine was fermented in the same way we produce grape wines, maximizing the aroma and flavors concentration. Enjoy our unique Lynfred Blueberry wine.

Mango Wine

During December we bottled another batch of our Best- Selling fruit wines, and particularly the favorite of our cellar crew: Mango wine. This new batch was made with fruit from Mexico. This delicious and fragrant wine has aromas of peaches, lychee, and that characteristic and refreshing mango flavor.

Cranberry wine

The last wine we bottled this month was Cranberry wine, this small batch features beautiful aromas and flavors of cranberry, cherry, flowers & herbs.

Still fermenting some fruits...


During this month of December, we have been fermenting an aromatic and crisp Pear juice from WA, USA, and a delicious batch of Plums from Chile!
