### Assemblage 2021

We are delighted to announce the bottling of our Assemblage 2021 on February 1st. Crafted using the innovative co-fermentation technique this wine embodies a harmonious blend of 50% Alicante Bouschet and 50% Malbec grapes sourced from the Columbia Valley, Washington. By fermenting these grapes together, we've unlocked fresh and intricate flavors exclusive to this method. Following fermentation, the wine matured for 24 months in American oak barrels, resulting in a smooth and elegant profile. Reserved exclusively for our discerning club members, Assemblage 2021 will be available for release on March 1st, 2024. Cheers to rare and complex wines!

## Cabernet Sauvignon 2021

We finalized and bottled our April wine of the month, the Lynfred Winery Cabernet Sauvignon Vintage 2021. Sourced from Kamiak Vineyards, Washington, the grapes benefit from the region's sunny climate and volcanic soil, yielding a distinctive Cabernet Sauvignon. This wine boasts a complex bouquet of violets, black cherry, cedarwood, and black pepper, embodying the essence of our terroir. Here's to elegance and complexity in every sip!

#### Strawberry

We are excited to introduce a new batch of Lynfred Strawberry wine, crafted from USA-grown fruit.
