Oktoberfest Wine

This July, we proudly bottled our delightful Oktoberfest Wine, a white wine that beautifully captures the essence of German winemaking traditions. Made from 100% Riesling grapes sourced from Columbia Valley, Washington, this wine impresses with its refreshing aromas and flavors of lychee, lime, honey, and citrus blossoms. It's a perfect reflection of classic Riesling characteristics.

Teroldego 2021

Following the Oktoberfest bottling, we completed the final blending and bottling of our October 2024 Wine of the Month: the outstanding Teroldego 2021. This spicy Italian red wine features the leading indigenous red variety from Trentino-Alto Adige, a northeastern region of Italy near the southern borders of Austria and Switzerland. In California, Teroldego has been cultivated for a couple of decades, producing wines that are typically bolder than their Italian counterparts. This versatile variety can be crafted in various styles, from young and fruity to aged and complex. Our full-bodied Teroldego 2021, made from grapes grown in Clarksburg, CA, showcases this versatility.

Sangria Rouge

This month, we also bottled a fresh batch of our delightful Sangria Rouge. This Spanish-inspired wine, with its fruity and refreshing taste, is perfect for enjoying during the hottest days of summer. Salud!
