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Sparkling Almond

Spring has arrived—and with it, a fresh pop of celebration. We're thrilled to unveil a new batch of our beloved Sparkling Almond, crafted in the signature Lynfred style. This effervescent beauty is a harmonious marriage of crisp, sparkling white wine and velvety almond essence. Nutty on the nose, fruity on the palate, and joyfully balanced throughout. And for the first time, it's now available in convenient 6-pack boxes—because some things are too good not to share.

Vin De City White

Our latest Vin De City White release is as lively and layered as the city streets that inspired it. This zesty blend is composed of 40% Sauvignon Blanc, 23% Chardonnay, 18% Riesling, 8% Albariño, 7% Muscat, and 4% Symphony—sourced from the cool climates of Washington's Columbia Valley and the sun-drenched slopes of Lodi, California. Fermented and aged in stainless steel, it's light-bodied and vibrant, bursting with aromas of pear, lemon, cantaloupe, lime, and green apple. On the palate, expect a citrusy chorus of grapefruit, white peach, mandarin, and just a whisper of rose. Ideal with seafood, grilled vegetables, or as an aperitif to brighten any evening.

Cherrivino

A legacy in liquid form, our Cherrivino is a port-style wine that captures the soul of the orchard. This month, we bottled the latest solera of this iconic blend, created from Montmorency cherries harvested in Door County, Wisconsin, and elevated with grape spirits from Fresno, California.

Aged over 72 months in American oak, the wine reveals decadent layers of maraschino cherry, praline, toasted nuts, caramel, and cedar. Rich, robust, and unapologetically unique, Cherrivino shines alongside bold cheeses like Gorgonzola or desserts with a tart twist—think sour cherry pie or dark chocolate torte.

Ruby Reserve

After the Cherrivino, we followed with another gem—our Ruby Reserve. This port-style treasure is blended from Petite Sirah, Zinfandel, and Sangiovese, all sourced from the fertile soils of Fresno. Fortified and aged for an average of five years in American oak barrels, Ruby Reserve unfurls with deep notes of prunes, raisins, mandarin, vanilla, and chocolate.

Luxurious and full-bodied, it's tailor-made for late-night indulgences: blue cheese, brownies, truffles, figs, or even crème brûlée. A bottle to be savored slowly, or shared in good company.

Oktoberfest

Yes, it's April—but we're already raising our steins to autumn. This month, we bottled our next vintage of Oktoberfest, a sweet, aromatic white wine inspired by the festive heart of Germany. Made from 100% Riesling, it brims with flavors of lime, lychee, citrus blossom, honey, peach, and ginger.

Pair it with bratwurst, potato salad, Bavarian pretzels—or go sweet with apple pie and cinnamon fritters. Whether you're dancing in lederhosen or lounging on a spring afternoon, this wine brings the gemütlichkeit.
