Strawberry

September began on a sweet note as we bottled a fresh batch of our beloved Strawberry wine. Brimming with the juicy essence of ripe berries, it offers a delicate bouquet and a smooth, refreshing finish. This fruit-forward favorite is the perfect companion for light desserts, fresh fruit, or those lingering golden afternoons as summer slips gracefully into fall.

Zinfandel 2022

Looking ahead, we've already bottled your featured red for February 2026: the Lynfred Zinfandel 2022. Sourced from old-vine grapes in the heart of Lodi, this vintage embodies the bold spirit and layered complexity that only mature vines can provide. Aromas of ripe cherries and plums intertwine with delicate violets, while subtle notes of vanilla and cedar linger on the finish. A wine of both power and elegance, ready to warm the winter season with timeless finesse.

Aranbois

We're also celebrating the release of a new batch of our signature port-style wine, Lynfred Aranbois. After more than four years aging in American oak, this unique blend of blueberry wine and Fresno grape spirits has blossomed into a rich, luxurious treat. Crafted in the spirit of Portugal's great ports, it delivers aromas and flavors both sweet and complex, making it a perfect partner for fine cheeses, decadent desserts, or slow evenings of pure indulgence.

Harvest Update

September brought an exhilarating rhythm to the cellar as the 2025 harvest reached full swing. California's vineyards delivered exceptional fruit, and each variety is showing incredible promise as fermentation takes shape.

From Lodi, we received a trio of crisp whites:

Symphony – floral and tropical, with an aromatic charm

Muscat of Alexandria – delicately sweet with a fragrant bouquet

Albariño – bright, zesty, and alive with ripe peach

Meanwhile, Clarksburg graced us with a lineup of powerful reds:

Teroldego – bold and structured, with deep color and ripe tannins

Tannat – intense, flavorful, and brimming with richness

Petite Sirah – concentrated and powerful, bursting with dark plums and sun-dried raisins

Tempranillo – elegantly balanced, layered with fruit and florals that echo its Spanish roots

Together, these varietals bring vibrancy, personality, and immense character to the cellar. Fermentations are steady and strong, and we're eager to watch as these young wines evolve into bottles worth savoring.
