Zinfandel 2022

Lodi and Zinfandel go together like old friends who finish each other's sentences. Known for its Mediterranean climate and heritage vines, Lodi produces some of the most expressive Zinfandels in the world.

Our 2022 Lynfred Zinfandel brims with aromas of ripe cherry, juicy plum, and delicate violet, beautifully framed by whispers of vanilla and spice. Smooth, rich, and refined, this is Zinfandel at its most charming.

Malbec 2022

Once a Bordeaux blending grape, Malbec found stardom in Argentina, and now shines brightly in Washington's Columbia Valley. This region's cool nights and warm days allow Malbec to reach elegant ripeness while preserving structure and depth.

Lineage 47th Anniversary

This October, we bottled our next chapter in celebration, Lineage 47th Anniversary, crafted with care a full year before its debut.

A blend of 75% Syrah, 10% Cabernet Sauvignon, 10% Carménère, and 5% Rosé, this wine tells the story of our lineage in every sip. It opens with bright acidity and floral intrigue before unfolding into layers of dark fruit, spice, and silky tannins. Notes of vanilla and toasted oak round out a finish that lingers like a fond memory.

Aranbois

After more than five years aging gracefully in American oak, we've bottled a new batch of Lynfred Aranbois, our exquisite blueberry port-style wine.

Crafted from Michigan blueberries and fortified with grape spirits from Fresno, this luscious dessert wine is inspired by the great ports of Portugal. Each sip reveals sweet, layered complexity, ripe fruit, soft spice, and a velvety finish that invites reflection (or another glass).

A true cellar treasure, perfect for pairing with cheese, dessert, or quiet celebration.

Pinot Grigio 2024

Bright, crisp, and effortlessly elegant, our 2024 Lynfred Pinot Grigio was crafted from Columbia Valley grapes, where cool breezes and mineral-rich soils lend freshness and finesse.

Notes of white peach, grapefruit, honeysuckle, and lemon zest dance on the palate, while a touch of Albariño adds a zesty lift of citrus blossom and green apple. Refreshing yet refined, it's a reminder that simplicity done well is pure sophistication.
