BARBERA 2022

As we wrapped up the final month of the year, we popped the cork on something special and bottled a fresh, vibrant, and downright juicy Barbera, Vintage 2022. This classic Italian red is the third most widely planted grape in Italy, and once you taste it, you will understand why it has such a loyal following.

You can expect bright flavors of raspberry and tart cherry, rounded out with just a touch of vanilla. Barbera is naturally low in mouth-drying tannins and high in refreshing acidity, which makes it incredibly food-friendly and easy to love. It is beautifully balanced and happy at the table, no matter what you are serving.

Pour a glass alongside your favorite cozy comfort foods and settle in. This is a wine made for warm kitchens, good meals, and unhurried evenings.

FRAMBOISE

After more than five years of patiently aging in American oak barrels, we are thrilled to bottle a new batch of our distinctive Lynfred Framboise, a raspberry port-style wine that is rich, aromatic, and full of flavor.

Inspired by traditional Portuguese port, this wine begins as a raspberry wine, is fortified with grape spirits from Fresno, California, and then aged slowly in American oak. Blended from multiple vintages, it delivers a sweet, fruity, and beautifully complex finish. It pairs wonderfully with cheese and dessert, but it is also perfectly content being enjoyed all on its own as a little after-dinner luxury.

MORE FRUIT WINES ON THE HORIZON

The cellar is never quiet for long. Right now, we have a crisp batch of cranberry juice from Wisconsin happily fermenting, along with five tons of juicy blueberries harvested across the USA. Each batch is moving along nicely, developing the character and personality that make our fruit wines so memorable.
