Symphony 2025

At the beginning of May, we bottled a limited batch of our third vintage of Symphony 2025.

Symphony is a grape variety developed in the mid-20th century at UC Davis through a cross between Muscat of Alexandria and Grenache Gris. Created specifically for California's warm Central Valley, Symphony has since found a thriving home in regions like Lodi and the Sierra Foothills. Known for its expressive aromatics, it is often blended into white wines to enhance both bouquet and flavor. True to its name, our Lynfred Winery Symphony 2025 is a harmonious medley of vibrant floral and tropical notes: refreshing, light, and perfect for leisurely sipping on a warm summer day.

Vin de City White

During May, we bottled a new batch of Vin de City White. This crisp and refreshing blend is composed of 48% Chardonnay, 42% Sauvignon Blanc, and 10% Riesling. Stainless steel aging keeps the wine bright, highlighting aromas of peach, lemon, lime, green apple, and soft floral notes. On the palate, it shows flavors of lemon, white peach, pear, and light herbal-mineral tones, finishing clean and citrus-driven. With its light body and 0.4% residual sugar, it is an easy-drinking white that pairs beautifully with fish, chicken, steamed seafood, grilled vegetables, or simply enjoyed as an aperitif.

Sangria Blanc

May brought a new bottling of our Sangria Blanc. This vibrant white sangria is crafted from a blend of 54% white wine and 46% passion fruit and pear, creating a bright, tropical profile. Aromas of passion fruit, peach, lemon, lime, orange, and pear lead into a juicy palate filled with peach, lime, mango, and orange notes. With its refreshing finish and lively fruit character, Sangria Blanc is perfect on its own, as a spritzer, or paired with fruit-forward desserts and light snacks.
